This resource pack should provide you with enough bits and pieces to play the game. It doesn't provide a model of the Nautilus (you'll have to draw that yourself) but it will do eventually.

The Cast

			
The Hero (Pluck = 10) He's got a whale of a tale to tell you, but you don't wanna know that. He's a Hero, pure and simple.	The Captain (Pluck = 10) He may not be as young as he was, but a mild psychosis and thirst for revenge will easily make up for that!	The Mate (Pluck = 9) The Captain's right hand man. He's top dog aboard ship. An unstoppable fighting machine... until a hero can find his weakness.	The Crew (Pluck = 7) Stalwart companions of the Captain, and fellow sufferers in his anguish. A good bunch of lads, and only slightly suicidal.

In order to make up the 50 points of pluck for the game, I would suggest taking each of the main characters (Hero, Captain & Mate) and three crew.

Once you get the hang of the game, you could try taking more figures with lower pluck values. There should be enough figures to try out a few different scenarios.
