

Assembling Folding Space-Station Interior "C"

The Maze

Print one copy of each of the pages. Assemble the walls and floor just like any of the other space-station interiors. Make sure each long wall is glued to its right place on the floor. The short walls are added in a zigzag pattern, like this:

The result is a mini-labyrinth of closets and storage areas, where the path from one room to another may be far from obvious.


If you need exterior walls for this module, use the ones from any of Gungnir's interiors.






Glue reverse to wall, then
glue unit to floor.




Folding SF Interior C - Walls - Sheet 2




Folding SF Interior C - Walls - Sheet 3




Glue reverse to wall, then
glue unit to floor.




