

Assembling Folding Space-Station Interior "J"

The Manufacturing Area

Exactly what are they manufacturing here? That depends on the needs of your adventure. Maybe they're cranking out illegal weapons, and need to be stopped. Maybe they were making copies of Linux, and they've been sabotaged by The Evil Empire, and you have to come up with the spare parts before it's too late. Or maybe they make small robots, and the process has gone badly wrong, and the halls are filling up with misprogrammed 'droids. Use your imagination!



Print one copy of each page. Assemble the walls and floor just like the other space-station interiors. Glue the machinery sections to the sections of wall marked for them, and to the floors. The numbers on the upper corners of each machine correspond to the numbers in the floorplan below, but the numbering isn't important. The flaps on one side of each machine fold down to partially hide the fact that they're just hollow boxes. The two small control panels go in the inside corners. It looks like this when done:


If you need exterior walls for this module, use the ones from any of Gungnir's interiors, preferably a set with just a few doors.







Folding SF Interior J - Walls 2





Folding SF Interior J - Interior Fittings
